IX. Criteria and Weightage for Admission

- Each criteria with respective weightages :
 - 1st Level : Students are called based on their performance in the entrance exam (XAT).
 - 2nd Level: Weightage is given as follows: XAT marks (50%); Work experience (10%); previous academic performance (10%), group discussion (10%); interview (20%)
 - At the end of group discussion and interview, interviewers are asked to choose one of the four options: a) Must take – 10 points; b) May take – 7 points; c) May not take – 3 points; and d) Should not take – 0 point. The maximum a student can get 30 points and the minimum 0 points.

First, the candidates who received 30 points are considered and they are rank ordered based on their scores in the 2nd level and selected accordingly. Then those who received 27 points are considered and so on until we get the required number of candidates.

- Being a minority institution, 50% of the seats are reserved for minority candidates.
- Cut-off levels of percentage & Percentile scores (section wise/total):

➤ Admission Test

: 80 Percentile for general with internal cut off score for each section & 55.75 percentile for minority
